

2023 ASSOCIATION DUES — PLEASE READ!

2023 Homes Association Dues will total \$90.00 for the year. Paying annual dues is an obligation and a fact of life when living in a subdivision—among other things, dues pay for lawn mowing of common areas, plowing snow from EVERYONE's streets, and salting intersections when needed.



2023 invoices will be mailed by mid-January. Please pay your dues when you receive your invoice. If you did not pay your 2022 dues, and/or there was a cumulative unpaid balance prior to 2022, your property will have been assessed a 6% interest fee on your unpaid balance as of December 31, 2022. This amount will be reflected on your 2023 invoice. If 2023 invoices are not received at the post office by March 31, 2023, a late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed, and all future collection efforts will be charged to the homeowner.

Dues notices are ALWAYS mailed out in January and are ALWAYS due by the end of March. Not receiving an invoice is not an excuse to not pay your dues—you can call the Board at (734) 448-1312 to request another invoice. We will post reminder signs at subdivision entrances in mid-March. Pay your dues on time before the March 31 deadline, and you'll have nothing to worry about! Please, mark your calendars!

On a positive note, the Board would like to sincerely thank those residents that look for the annual dues notice in the mail and send in their dues before the March 31 deadline! Your proactive response helps keep our neighborhood running and saves our volunteer Treasurer the added work of sending you a late notice.

Thank You! Thank you to all our conscientious homeowners who mailed in their dues payment before the due date! Your efforts are MUCH appreciated!

REMINDERS

OUTDOOR PETS

It is a Canton Ordinance that **you must have** control of your pet(s) at **ALL times**. For the safety of your pet **AND our residents**, that means keeping your dog on **YOUR** property and having your dog on a leash when you go for a walk. PLEASE **clean up** after your pets as you go. Canton Twp. Ordinance officers have had many complaints of dog owners not following these requirements, and there is a hefty fine for violators. To report a problem, call the Canton Ordinance Officer for our area, Kay Longton, at (734) 394-5210.

We have residents asking dog walkers who use retracting/long leashes to please use them at the standard leash length when walking past homes and extend only when walking past the parks.

Residents really DO appreciate your efforts to do the right thing!

COMMON AREAS, EASEMENTS, AND FENCE LINES

Looking forward to the weather warming up, this is another friendly reminder to not dump your leaves, grass clippings, or garbage in the common areas and easements of our subdivision. Weekly compost pickup for our subdivision starts again on Thursday, April 7. As you spend more time outside, please take a look along your fence lines and clean up any garbage that might have collected there during the winter months. Your neighbors will thank you for it!!

PUBLIC VS PRIVATE PROPERTY

As you look forward to spring and sprucing up your property with new plants or a vegetable garden, please be mindful of the boundaries of your own property and keep these plantings on your property—please do not plant out into the easements or parks. Please do not cut the grass around the park and baseball diamonds. The board has a contracted lawn care company, and our annual dues pay for this work. Thank you to all our residents who take such great care of their yards... Let's let our lawn care company do the rest!

PLEASE SLOW DOWN! OUR SUBDIVISION'S SPEED LIMIT IS 25 MPH.

Why are drivers ignoring the speed limit? Please watch out for kids and check your speed as you drive through our streets. The speed limit is 25 mph and that is fast enough! Residents throughout the entire subdivision have witnessed drivers going **TOO FAST**. There is **NO** excuse for speeding. The more we contact police and report speeders, the more they will patrol our subdivision. Complaints can be called in to the Canton Police at (734) 394-5400, and if you happen to get a license plate number of a specific vehicle, they will add that to the report as well.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING/ COMPOST PICKUP

All trash (garbage), recycling bins, and compost are to be placed at curbside no earlier than 6 p.m. the evening before pickup day. Canton Township limits cans to 32 gallons or less in capacity and no more than 50 lbs. in weight. **Each type of pickup should be separated** (e.g. garbage bags or cans on one side of the driveway, recycling bins and labeled compost bags on the other). According to Canton Waste and Recycling, the 2023 **compost pickup season is April 3 – December 15** (first day for our subdivision is **April 6**).

Only yard waste is considered compost, meaning lawn clippings, plants, sticks, etc. The container for compost must be labeled as such. Labels may be picked up at the Administration Building. Compost can be placed in lawn bags easily purchased at local stores.

WHAT DO OUR SUBDIVISION DUES PAY FOR?

Paying dues is not a choice but an obligation for every Brookside resident. The HOA fee covers a variety of things; lawn mowing of common areas, plowing snow from EVERYONE's streets, and salting intersections when needed.

Here are some specifics for 2023:

Snow Removal Contract \$15,500.00

Lawn Maintenance Contract \$15,000.00

Maintenance of Common Areas, Parks,

and Pond; Mulch for playscapes \$14,750.00

Additional items budgeted for this year are: taxes; insurance; printing and delivering the subdivision newsletter six times a year; office supplies and postage for mailing the dues notices and subsequent past-due notices; Food, drink, bounce house and etc. for The Fall Festival; Easter eggs filled with goodies and prizes for the Easter Egg Hunt (ending in 2023/unless more volunteers); electricity for our two parks; and additional/entryway/creek maintenance and clean up.

Volunteer Board members spend time every year collecting bids for the snow removal and lawn care contracts on behalf of our subdivision residents. If you would like to join the discussions about our contracted companies or the work that is being done, please call the Board at (734) 448-1312 to find out which meetings you should attend.

The Board meets every first Thursday of the month in the Township Building, 1150 S. Canton Center Road, Lower Level, at 6:30 p.m.
